Based in the grounds of Knebworth house (viewing by appointment only) I am a chainsaw artist, most of my work is public artwork the work is rustic I carve large pieces of wood into sculptured seating, figures and totem poles. I was a fellow of Digswell Arts Trust. The work being of natural, sustainable material enhances any environment

Before I started carving with a chainsaw I was a forester for some years and my passion for wildlife and conservation inspired me to take up carving with the chainsaw, I started carving to salvage the wood from the fire.

I have featured in many magazines in the U.K. and America and many local papers also the 6 o'clock news in America.

Since March 2001 I have become disabled (partially sighted) with a Genetic eye disorder, this does not affect my carving, but as you can see I am still at it.
